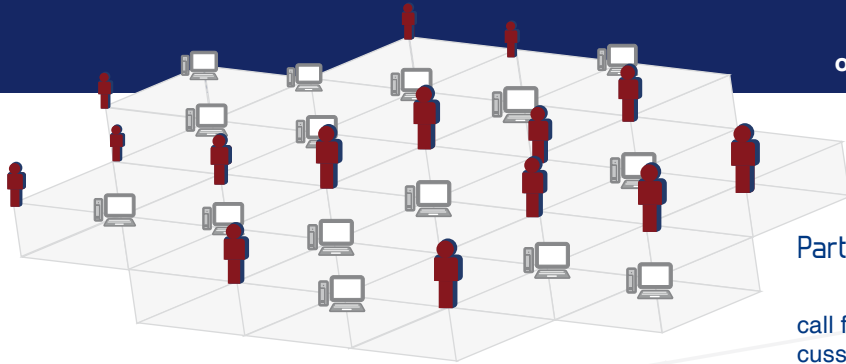
What is it?
